1 1/8 MILES. (1.47) 84TH RUNNING OF THE WOOD MEMORIAL. Grade I. Purse \$750,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$750 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box; \$4,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. A bonus of \$100,000 (which will follow the horse) will be presented to the trainer of the horse which wins both The Wood Memorial and The Kentucky Derby. Closed Saturday, March 22, 2008 with 33 Nominations and 1 Free Nominations (Gotham winner Visionaire).

TALE OF EKATI raced close up outside while in hand, advanced outside on the second turn, angled to the inside in upper stretch, dug in gamely on the rail and was up in time. WAR PASS quickly showed in front, set the pace under pressure from INNER LIGHT, put away that rival and drew clear on the second turn, took a clear lead past the eighth pole and dug in gamely but could not hold off the winner. COURT VISION was outrun early, put in a five wide run on the second turn and finished well on the far outside. GIANT MOON raced in hand inside, saved ground, rallied inside on the second turn and stayed on well on the rail. ANAK NAKAL was outrun early, put in a five wide run on the second turn and had little left for the stretch drive. SPURRIER was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. ROMAN EMPEROR was outrun early, was steadied along the inside on the second turn and tired. TEXAS WILDCATTER chased the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters. INNER LIGHT pressed the pace from the outside and was finished after a half mile.
