

1 1/8 MILES. (Turf) (1:44) 37TH RUNNING OF THE CALDER DERBY. Grade III. Purse \$400,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$400 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$2,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$2,500 to start - with \$400,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$50,000 at a mile or over, 5 lbs.; \$35,000 or non-winners of two races other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter at a mile or over, 7 lbs. Graded placed horses at equal weights preferred. Graded stakes winners preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. (1) Supplemental nomination of \$6,000 to enter and start. Closed Wednesday, April 16, 2008 with 18 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

SPORTING ART rated off the pace after being steadied on the first turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. TOUR IRELAND vied for the lead along the hedge, opened a clear lead on the far turn, then was being outfinished when he ducked in at the gap in deep stretch and just saved the place. EL SULTRY SUN reserved off the pace, advanced five wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. RUN SULLY RUN bumped hard with HIGHLY HONORED soon after the start, was steadied to avoid running up on rivals on the first turn and again on the backstretch, saved ground into the stretch, eased out while advancing to reach the attending position in the stretch, then gave way. TITAN OF INDUSTRY stalked the pace, was steadied in behind rivals on the far turn and failed to recover. FLYING DISMOUNT outrun early, checked to avoid running up on SPORTING ART on the far turn, moved into contention in the stretch but had no further response. HIGHLY HONORED steadied when he bumped soundly with RUN SULLY RUN in the early going but never threatened. ACAI unhurried early, was saving ground when checked inside TITAN OF INDUSTRY on the far turn, then was not a factor. WISE ANSWER stalked the pace, made a run three wide to join the leaders racing into the far turn, then tired. HE'S EZE stalked the pace four wide, made a run to reach the leaders entering the far turn, then faltered. DREAM MAESTRO vied for the lead into the far turn, then faded.
