No nomination fee. \$3,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$3,000 to start with \$400,000 guaranteed of which \$225,000 to the owner of the winner, \$75,000 to second, \$41,250 to third, \$22,500 to fourth, \$11,250 to fifth and \$5,000 for placing sixth through tenth. If less than ten horses start the purse money not distributed will revert to the winning owner. Weight: Colts and Geldings, 122 lbs. Fillies, 117 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. In allowance stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings at time of entry as determined by the information provided by Equibase Company. The field will be limited to fourteen starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. The winning owner, trainer, and jockey to receive a trophy. EL GATO MALO jostled with a rival entering the first turn, settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the far turn, forced his way out and bumped with TEXAS WILDCATTER at the top of the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. LEONIDES tracked the pace, chased the leader on the far turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and just missed. SAMBA ROOSTER quickly took the lead after the start, set the pace through solid fractions, gamely led into the final furlong but was overtaken. LIMESTONE EDGE was well placed on the inside, came under a ride leaving the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn, lacked room passing the furlong marker then weakened. MY PAL CHARLIE raced four then three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. TEXAS WILDCATTER was in a bit tight entering the first turn, raced four then three wide on that turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, bumped with EL GATO MALO at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. GOLDEN YANK lingered towards the rear of the field, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. KING'S SILVER SON showed no speed from the gate and quickly dropped back, lagged near the back of the field, raced three then four wide on the far turn, dropped in at the top of the stretch and also failed to threaten. IDE LIKE A DOUBLE was fractious in the gate, raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was ridden along while four to five wide on the far turn and was no factor. REAL APPEAL went six wide early on the first turn then dropped to three wide, settled towards the back of the field, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. FORT APACHE lagged near the back of the field, raced four then five wide on the far turn and showed little. PONI COLADA jostled with a rival entering the first turn then was in tight, dropped back on the backstretch and also failed to respond. ISABULL was caught five wide into the first turn then dropped in, raced off the pace, came up empty while saving ground on the far turn and retreated.
