BRILLIANT SPEED outrun along the inside while unhurried, came off the rail late on the second turn, angled out further once in the stretch and finished full of run to be up in the final stride. TWINSPIRED forwardly placed off the inside while patiently handled, moved up after six furlongs, challenged once in the stretch, drew clear with a furlong to go but was outfinished. KING CONGIE bothered at the start, then was in tight near the finish line the first turn, was reserved off the inside, angled out four wide leaving the second turn when rallying and closed well to miss. NEWSADAD forced in at the start, pulled the opening half mile behind SANTIVA, angled out a bit for the drive, steadied in midstretch when blocked then rallied willingly late. CRIMSON CHINA sluggish at the start, angled in, steadied near the finish line the first turn, was outrun for six furlongs, commenced his rally three wide on the second turn, angled out for the drive and late a solid late bid. JOES BLAZING AARON bore in at the start, was straightened, set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and tired. QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN stumbled at the start, quickly gaining good position four wide, stayed on well to the stretch, drifted in with a furlong to go tightening up WILKINSON then tired. WILL COX INN within striking distance three wide, leaned on SANTIVA in midstretch keeping that one in behind a tiring leader then lacked a closing bid. SANTIVA bothered at the start, recovered and was in hand along the inside while within reach, was pinned up by WIL COX INN in midstretch when attempting to angle out for a clear path then could not threaten. WILKINSON reserved early, moved closer before a half, maintained good position to the stretch, steadied in midstretch when in tight then tired. PRAETEREO closest to the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and gave way. SENSATIONAL SLAM close up early off the inside, faded.
