ARCHARCHARCH allowed the pace to go early while racing outside, four wide into and through the second turn when beginning to advance, reached the front inside the furlong grounds, briefly got clear, enough left to hold the runner up safe in the late going. NEHRO broke well, fell immediately back toward the inside, continued unhurried in the run up the backstretch, came four wide and trouble free into the lane, late surge to be rapidly getting to the winner in the final strides. DANCE CITY reluctant to load, broke in good order, chased the leader, moved up to challenge between foes far turn, vied into the lane, bothered along the rail inside the furlong marker, finished up best of the rest. SWAY AWAY broke out, rank, wide into and through the first turn, continued wide, ranged up, challenged 5w 2nd turn, led past the furlong marker, drifted, lugged in, weakened in the late going. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. ALTERNATION off slowly, fell far back, continued to trail, swung out widest for the drive, finished full of run to be going well at the end while too late well out in the strip. J W BLUE off slowly, raced back, came six wide out of the final turn, also displayed some late interest. THE FACTOR away well, moved off the inside first turn, stalked in the run up the backstretch under restraint, ranged up to challenge three wide second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. J P'S GUSTO broke sharp, soon got clear, showed the way for six furlongs two path, gave way when headed into the stretch. ELITE ALEX settled off the pace, raced in traffic while in the second flight through the second turn, came up empty in the drive. SARATOGA RED raced off the pace and the inside had little for the drive. BRETHREN bumped soon after the start, got out a bit in the first turn, firmly rated, traffic late backstretch, faded through the lane. CALEB'S POSSE pinched back at the start, raced well back as a result, managed little in the way of a rally. TRUMAN'S COMMANDER allowed to settle along the inside, gave way after five furlongs.
