By subscription of \$200 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box; \$1,000 to start. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$150,000; or \$45,000 twice allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000; or \$35,000 at a mile or over in 2007 allowed 5 lbs.; three races other maiden or claiming, 7 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming, Starter, Restricted or Restricted Stake races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The winner of the Gotham to receive a free nomination to The Wood Memorial. Closed Saturday, February 24, 2007 with 34 Nominations.

COWTOWN CAT raced close up along the inside while in hand, came around pacesetter WOLLASTON BAY nearing the stretch, was crowded a bit by SUMMER DOLDRUMS in upper stretch but leveled off once straightened away, responded when roused, caught WAFI CITY inside the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. WAFI CITY pressed the pace from the outside, drew clear when roused in upper stretch, could not resist the winner late and stayed on to hold the place. SUMMER DOLDRUMS raced close up outside, was caught three wide on both turns, rallied into the stretch and stayed on well outside. SIR WHIMSEY was outrun early advanced three wide on the second turn and offered a mild rally outside. MINT SLEWLEP was outrun early, raced inside and offered a mild rally on the rail. LONGLEY was four wide around both turns and faded in the final furlong. WOLLASTON BAY was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside and was steadied while tiring in upper stretch. HOW SWEET HE IS raced between rivals and was finished after a half mile. BELIEVEINMENOW dropped back early and was outrun along the inside.
