MYSTIK DAN tracked the leaders in rail skimmingfashion, slipped throughtomakea bold bid nearing the quarter pole, came tolevel terms entering the stretch, shook clear approaching the furlong marker, dugindoggedly and was fully extended to prevail by the slimmest of margins. SIERRA LEONE settled in hand, tucked in along the rail, shifted out a bit on the backstretch, took closer order between rivals through the second turn, worked his way out eight wide entering the stretch, exchanged bumps with FOREVER YOUNG (JPN) from the three-sixteenths pole to the furlong grounds, fought on tenaciously under sternleft handed urging but was denied. FOREVER YOUNG (JPN) lunged at the start andwas away slow, was caught in traffic into the first turn and steadied near thefifteen-sixteenths pole, leveled into stride and moved out five wide, mounted a long drive a half mile out, moved up swiftly through the second turn, came seven wide into the stretch, swapped bumps repeatedly with SIERRA LEONE throughtheupper stretch,battledonstubbornly betweenrivalsthereafter but wasnarrowly bested. CATCHING FREEDOMsettled off of the inside, tucked in on the secondturn, followed the winner into the lane along the inside, continued on well andwas making up ground. T O PASSWORD (JPN) broke a step slow, checked in trafficinto the first turn, settled off the inside into the backstretch, came under a ride nearingthe seven-sixteenths pole, looped seven wide through the secondturnand into the stretch, had the jockey lose the crop near the furlong markerand continued on well under a fierce hand ride. RESILIENCE settled in pursuit from midpack three wide, ranged up with a bold six wide gain turning for home tobid along with inner rivals entering the lane but failed to keep pace withhisinnermost counterpart inupper stretch, got outkicked for place betweenrivalsin midstretch and yielded. STRONGHOLD stalked behind the leaders and from the three path around the first turn, came under rousing within striking range inthe four path turningfor home, bid along withrivals on both sidesenteringthelane, but failed to keep pace with hisinner counterpart while getting brushedand floatedinwardly by anouter rival inupper stretch and gave way. HONORMARIE was jostled hard early between rivals, settled toward the inside, was caught intraffic and steadied into the first turn, leveled into stride while saving ground, moved up on the second turn, veered out sharply inside the three-sixteenths and boxed on willingly. ENDLESSLY leaned outwardly at thestart, was allowed to settle at the rear along the inside, improved in the three to four path and between horses around the far turn before swinging ten wideinto the lane, then moved up willingly without reaching contention. DORNOCH settled saving ground, was shuffled back in traffic inside the half mile marker, came again between foes, wasbumped and checkedhardoff heelsnear the guarterpole, angled out into the stretchbut came up empty in the drive. TRACK PHANTOM showed the way inside of a pair of prompting foes, remained hounded inside of rivals one path off the rail around the far turn but was headed by challengerson either side entering the lane and folded. WEST SARATOGA raced forwardly twowide and between horses, chased from the two to three patharound the far turn, was bumped and jostled by an inner rival to the four to five path entering the lane, was brushed again by an inner foe in upper stretch and gave way. DOMESTIC PRODUCT broke a step slow before being bumped and pinchedbetween horsesat the start, tugged while off of the pace four wide into the first turn, got brushedand put into tight quarters between foes while getting outmoved by a wider rival around the far turn, shifted to the nine path into the lane and passed tiredones. EPIC RIDE stalked outside of the leading trio, came under a drive in the five path and betweenhorses around the far turn but retreated entering the lane then shied from an inner foe andbrushed an outer rival at the three sixteenthspole andfaded. FIERCENESS hopped at the start, prompted the pace three deep, viedin the four patharound the far turn, but was surpassedby an outer pairand an inner bidder enteringthe lane and folded between horses. SOCIETY MANraced off of the pace four wide, then faded between horses around the far turn.JUST STEEL was bumped hard early, was quickly into stride and contested the pace between horses, faltered midway through the second turn and faded. GRAND MO THEFIRST brushed aninner rival at thestart, steadied among foespassing the wire for the first time, laid well backin the three path, came underurging in the four pathapproaching the five furlong pole then gave way in the six patharound the far turn. CATALYTIC contended along the inside to the second turn and dropped out. JUST A TOUCH was bumped early, settledbetween horses, moved intocontention on the second turn, was bumped in traffic near the five-sixteenthspole andcame up empty thereafter.
