CORPORATE POWER, forwardly placed four wide, took closer order leaving the farturn, saw the leaders get away a bit leaving the three sixteenths, picked things back up under left handed encouragement, leaned in slightly exchanging contact with IMPERIAL GUN near the sixteenth pole, corrected to sustain his bid then got the bob at the wire. GOULD'S GOLD prompted the pace two wide outside the leader, moved to apply more pressure while in hand past the three eighths, dueled, shook clear under a drive leaving the furlong grounds, dug in when confronted by outer rivals inside the sixteenth marker, kept on in valiant fashion and was nipped at the line. IMPERIAL GUN, a bit washy, raced in close attendance three wide and between horses, dropped back a bit nearing the lane, bumped with the winner when working outward for room near the sixteenth marker then came back gamely between foes. REAL MACHO steadied when in tight at the break, regrouped and settled well back off the inside, angled six wide under a ride in upper stretch and finished with interest. DAILY GRIND sped to the front then dropped in towards the rail, took pressure into the far turn then dueled, stayed on well past midstretch then weakened late. D DAY SKY, between foes early, edged up some nearing thefar turn, chased wide into the lane but came up empty. CIRCLEP, off a beatslow, raced between foes near the half, angled into gain pastthefive sixteenths, had aim into the stretch, failed to kick on in mid stretch and weakened. DEPOSITION steadied off heels into the first turn, recovered and saved ground stalking, lacked a punch leaving the far turn and gave way. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run and an objection by the rider of IMPERIAL GUN against the winner alleging interference in late stretch. No action was taken.
