B. f, (Apr), by Square Eddie - Puff Pastry, by Momentum. Trainer O'Neill Doug. Bred by Reddam Racing LLC (Cal). STAY AND SCAM closest in pursuit from the two path early, pressed the pace setter from outside on the backstretch, drew on even terms around the far turn, kicked clear into the stretch and held well under right handed encouragement and steady handling. MOMENT'S PLEASURE stalked from the two path then between rivals, continued two wide into the far turn, bumped with inner rival past the five-sixteenths pole, moved to the rail inside the quarter pole, steered back out in the lane and closed the gap on the winner while gaining second. CORNELIA FORT got crowded and bumped between rivals early, traveled in mid-pack two wide early. went two then three wide around the far turn, altered out in upper stretch and rallied to get up for third, CARMEN MIRANDA settled next to the fence off the pace, went between rivals on the far turn, came back in some in upper stretch, kept on through the final furlong but got edged by CORNELIA FORT for the show honors. SNEAKER took control early and moved inside, set the pace under pressure in the middle stages, headed at the five-sixte enths pole, could not keep up with the new leader leaving the far turn and weakened in the furlong grounds. ABHITA unhurried early on and tucked inside, shifted to the two path at the quarter pole, came out and bumped rival late on the bend and spun four wide into the stretch, kept trying through the stretch but failed to threaten. SHEZ MISBEHAVING got put in tight and bumped with outer rival early, raced near the back in the two path, went three deep into the far turn, got bumped and for ced out past the quarter pole, was floated out further in upper stretch and could not rally, bled following the race and was vanned off. MADIHA stalked three wide around both turns, drifted out in upper stretch, came back in midstretch and weakened. ROSE DAWSON traveled outside a rival at the back in the early stages, trailed two to three wide on the far turn and failed to make an impact. TAM'S LITTLE ANGEL stalked along the rail, bumped with outer rival past the five-sixteenths pole, continued along the fence and weakened down the lane.
