A payment of \$500.00 is required to pass the entry box and an additional \$400.00 is required to start. The purse will be divided \$30,000 to the owner of the winner, \$10,000 to the second place finisher, \$5,000 to the third place finisher, \$2,500 to the fourth place finisher and \$1,000 to the fifth place finisher. A payment of \$500.00 will be paid to all horses who start and finish sixth or worse. High weights preferred. Starters to be named through the entry box by the closing time of entries. The field will be limited to 12 starters. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner.

CLASSY CITY unhurried in the early going to bethe lone tracker, closed ground to the top of the lane, angled in to sneak up the fence when given the opportunity and closed well up the fence to pull away in deep stretch. SKIPPER'S PRIDE stalked the pace from three wide down the backside, dueled from between horses from midway on the turn to late in the lane, dug-in determinedly but was outkicked by the winner. MR FILLIP bumped leaving the gate, raced two wide pressing the pace to the turn, battled from three wide between rivals through the turn, continued on down the lane and was out-finished late. NOW N LATER GATOR set a pressured pace from the rail to upper stretch while under constant pressure, responded well to contend to inside the eighth pole and weakened deep in the drive. ITSALLGOODMAN raced up down the backside to press the leaders from four wide and flattened out in upper stretch.
