BELLASPINA was off the pace and had a mild gain on the turn but was no real thr eat. GLITTER BAY was unhurried early and hustled along on the turn but failed to fire. SPIRIT BELLE was hustled early but chased on the turn and was not a factor. SIL VER CANDICE was intouch, hadto check going into the turn and from the five path at the top of the stretch had no impact.
