JAN'S GIRL raced off the early pace four wide, advanced six wide around the far turn, bid near the quarter pole, vied to midstretch, was no match for the winner and held on the place. ANGEL NADESHIKO raced in range three wide, bid between foes rounding the far turn, briefly led, vied to midstretch and held on for the show. CHICK'S SHADOW raced off the pace four wide, circled seven wide around the far turn and flattened out in the lane. NO VALLA was bumped between foes at the start, chased the pace two and three wide and lacked the needed stretch rally. FRIENDLYPERSUASION was in tight at the start, saved ground off the pace and never threatened. TOWSER bumped at the start, raced three wide in midpack around the first turn, launched a five wide bid around the far turn, led near the five-sixteenths marker but came upempty in the lane. SWOONATRA vied inside around the first turn, settled back late on the bend, re-bid two wide around the far turn but faltered nearing the lane. EMPRESS ELLIE was bumped at the start, chased the pace inside and retreated through the lane. WIDE WEST (IRE) dueled two wide around the first turn, drew clear down the backstretch, vied inside around most of the far turn, stopped and was eased in the lane. NAPA CANDY broke in a tangle, pulled up entering the first turn and walked off.
