SUGAR FISH stumbled badly leaving the gate, allowed to settle along the inside, moved into range early on the backstretch then drew closer inside a pair of rivals, given her cue past the three-eighths pole, challenged from the fence at the five-six teenths marker and surged past outer rivals, asked right handed into the lane, switch to the left hand in upper stretch and widened through the final furlong. NOTHING LIKE YOU stalked four then three wide around the clubhouse turn, bid three deep midway on the far turn but could not keep up with SUGAR FISH approaching the quarter pole, chased outside JANE AUSTEN through the lane and outfinished that rival for second. JANE AUSTEN stumble da bit leaving the gate but recovere diguickly took control early, led two wide then along the rail on the clubhouse turn, showed the way up the backstretch, challenged on both sides at the five-sixteenths pole, started to drift out and relinquished the lead to SUGAR FISH, corrected and chased the new leader two wide into the lane and got outkicked for the place honors. SHOW CARD forwardly placed three then two wide outside the leader early, stalked between rivals leaving the backstretch, began to weaken on the far turn, trailed near the inside into the lane and had little left for the stretch.
