PLAY THE MUSIC settled inside the second flight tracking the leading pair, saved ground on the turn, came out a bit for the drive, found plenty of room inside the leader to bid nearing the furlong grounds, took command and drove clear. SECRET MONEY stalked from between runners in the second flight, angled eight wide at the top of the stretch, kicked on well late to get up for place. MISS SPEEDY quickly moved clear, set the pace from off the rail in the three path, drifted out a bit turning for home, was overtaken a furlong out and outkicked. DOLCE SOPRESA was unhurried early racing near the rail, came out six wide in upper stretch, passed between foes then shifted back in a bit late, kept on evenly. STAR CANDY stalked from outside four to six wide on the turn, took closer order late on that bend looming a threat in upper stretch while coming out a bit further, evened out in the lane. BABY NO WORRIES was in a bit tight at the start, lacked early speed bringing up the rear, swung ten wide turning into upper stretch, kicked on with mild late interest but needed more. BLIND SPOT raced between foes a bit in the early going off the leaders in the back half of the field, shifted seven wide turning for home, checked at the quarter pole, ran on evenly late. AWESOME TREAT raced outside runners back of the leaders, was in the third flight into the turn racing four to six deep, swung nine wide for the drive, was near striking distance but lacked the needed late kick. PEACOCK LASS settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn but failed to menace. HOWBOUTDE MAPPLES broke outwardly, pressed the pace from outside, went four wide on the turn, drifted six deep turning into upper stretch then back in a bit, faltered and faded. FOLLOWING AN OBJECTION BY THE RIDER OF BLIND SPOT AGAINSTSECRET MONEY ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH. THE LATTER WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND PLACED SEVENTH BEHIND THE FORMER.
