NEXT for wardly placed from the start, raced three paths off the inside past the stands the initial time before tucking to the two path through the first turn, settled two to three wide in closest aim of the leader remaining patiently handled applying no pressure save through his presence to the outside, got given a notch three wide midway on the far turn and advanced to take over command just outside the quarter pole, swung four then three wide straightened a way into upper stretch given a nudge by the rider, received a tap a furlong out to the right shoulder went clear under very light urging and prevailed comfortably at the finish. CRUPI brushed the near side stall at the break, raced four to five paths off the rail through the stretch the first turn before tucking to the two path through the first turn, tippe dout four wide down the backstretch, came under coaxing four to five wide with seven-sixteenths to go and advanced outside rivals before swinging seven wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while offering up a mild kick to secure the place honors in the latestages. DRAKE'S PASSAGE established the front and showed the way just off the inside under a rating hold through sensible splits and under the watchfuleye of NEXT to the outside, was along the inside through the first turn before tipping back out to the two path down the backstretch, remained just off the inside through the far turn and came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths facing pressure for the initial time by the top one, spun just off the inside into upper stretch displaced from the front, proved no match through the stretch while running on to the finish and was bested in the late going for the place honors while well clear for the show. MASQUEPARADE four wide in the stretch the first turn, went three wide through the first turn, chased three to four wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. DAIVERNON two to three wide early on, chased two to three wide coming under prolonged coaxing from the half mile pole, cornered two to three wide into upper stretch and weakened. SPENCER'S BOY LUNA three to four wide past the stands just after the start, tucked inside through the first turn, chased three wide down the backstretch and through the far turn under coaxing from the half mile pole, angled five wide into upper stretch and tired. LURE HIM IN stumbled at the start, recovered to race forwardly placed just off the inside and then along the inside through the opening six furlongs, began to fade and continued along the inside through the far turn given a nudgemidway but not fully engaged by the rider while in retreat, swung four wide into upper stretch and faltered in the drive.
