DOMESTIC PRODUCT stalked the pace on the outside, ranged up three wide to make a bid on the turn, was asked nearing the quarter-pole, took the lead into upper stretch then kicked clear, drifted in when the rider un-cocked his crop with the right-hand near the furlong marker, wide ned along the rail then was given one pop of a left-handed crop coming to the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under a solid hand-ride from that point to the finish. HADES showed speed then tracked the pace under coaxing, chased in the two path early on the turn, moved to the four path while dropping back near the five-sixteenths pole, spun five wide into the stretch and safely secured the place. BILLAL was hustled to the front, showed the way down the backstretch, was asked under threat while inside on the turn, moved to the two path outside the quarter-pole, lost the advantage to the winner into upper stretch and tired. SAVE THE TREES settled at the rear of the quartet, was roused while moving from three to five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
