Purse \$125,000 (includes \$25,000 KTDF – Kentucky TB Devt Fund) **FOR FILLIES THREE-YEAR-OLDS.** Free nomination, \$375 to pass the entry box and \$375 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry by payment of \$1,500 (includes entry and starting fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed plus an additional \$25,000 KTDF for KTDF eligible horses. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth Weight: 122 lbs. Non Winners of a sweepstakes on the turf in 2024 allowed 2, lbs. two races other than maiden or claiming in 2024, allowed 4 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed Saturday, June 22, 2024 with 26 nominations. The maximum number of starters will be determined at time of entry dependent on rail placement. Preference to start will be given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III) then those horses having accumulated the highest lifetime earnings. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Saturday, June 22, 2024 with 26. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five and One Half furlongs.)

NIKI NINE DOORS tracked the pace early on, raced in the four path into the lane, made a bid down the lane, drove past the leader and cleared the field. QUIMICHIS chased the pace early on, was on the inside into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but was no match for the winner late in the stretch run. MS. TART raced back early on, was in the four path into the lane, rallied down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. MOONLIT LADY bobbed at the start, pressed the pace early on, was in the three path into the lane, took over and inched clear near the eighth pole but faltered late in the drive. READY FOR TROUBLE was unhurried early on, raced in the three path into the lane and moved up late in the stretch run. VISUALLY trailed the field early on, was in the five path into the lane with a belated gain in the stretch drive. TWIRL AROUND stalked the pace early, raced in the three path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch. HIGH FASHION KATE set the pace from the outset, raced in the two path into the lane and gave way down the lane. TX WOMEN FOR ARTS was never a threat. THESE APPLES raced in the two path into the lane and was empty late in the stretch. FIELD LASS was never a factor. CAROLINA CANDY was through after a half.
