AT ATTENTION unhurried early while trailing the field into the stretch the first time, bided his time at the back of the pack in the run down the backstretch launched his bid five wide entering the final turn, and closed determinedly four wide in the drive to be up in the final stride. SUNBIRD settled off the early pace while racing three wide through the stretch the first time. advanced quickly from the outside midway down the backstretch, continued a four wide bid through the final turn, took control entering the lane, and just failed to last. SPACE stalked the leaders through the stretch the first time while saving ground at the rail, maintained his position in the run down the backstretch, rallie dalong the inside entering the final turn, and closed willingly two wide in the drive to grab a share in a solid effort. SETTECENTO settled well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the lane the first time, maintained his position in the run down the backside, commenced his bid three wide entering the final turn, and finished willingly four out from the rail in the drive. BOLD ARCH away well and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, dictated the pace in the run down the backstretch and into the final turn, was overtaken by SUNBIRD entering the lane, and outfinished late. STORMY BLUE stalked the leaders through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, maintained his position from between rivals in the run down the backside, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, and finished from along the rail in the drive. BIG UNION broke sharply and stalked the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the stretch the first time, held his position in the run down the backside, rallied two wide entering the final turn, but needed more in the late stages when called upon. SOARI NGFORTHES UN away alertly and stalked the pacesetter one out from the railthrough the stretch the first time, struggled to keep his position in ther un to the final turn, raced two wide into the final turn but lacked the needed closing response when called upon. BAKKEN OVERDRIVE tracked the leader through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, continued to chase the leader two wide into the final turn, but weakened over the final furlong.
