High Weights preferred. Lifetime earnings as recorded by Equibase will be used in determining preference of horses assigned equal weights. Starters to be named through the entry box by closing time of entries. Field limited to 12 starters.

AVANA settled at the back of the pack while shifting off the rail entering the stretch the first time, angled in towards to the rail to begin gaining on the leaders entering the backstretch, continued to save ground through the final turn, overtook the pacesetter from along the rail entering the lane, and drew clear under confident handling as much the best. VIVA LA DIVA away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, controlled the pace at the rail through the second turn, rallied from along the inside entering the final turn, drifted three wide entering the lane, and finished well to hold the place. DONNA WYN broke sharply and was allowed to settle off the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the stretch the first time, angled off the rail for the run down the backside, rallied smartly two wide entering the final turn, and finished three wide in the drive to garner a share. LONIE MO tracked the pacesetter through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, forced the issue two wide in the run to the final turn, rallied one out from the rail through the turn, but weakened in the drive.
