SUPERSECRET WEAPON was bumped at the start then stalked the pace while two wide, came under coaxing leaving the far turn torally bid in the early stretch, could not overcome the leader and gave way and held onto the show winnings. SPECIAL MEMORY tracked the pace while two wide early, then moved up three wide to urge steadily on the far turn, rallied a brief bid in the upper stretch then gave way. VICTORY FOR VETS was brushed at the start, raced mid pack while two wide in the early stages, rallied bid on the far turn, drifted out four wide and bumped foe then gave way. BANDERA BLING was no threat. NIGHTWIND tracked the pace from the inside, was in a long drive on the far turn to rally a mild bid in the upper stretch then stopped. STANS HOME RUN broke inwardly and bumped foe and was no factor. IBERIAN RUNNER was no rally.
