THE QUEENS M G five wide in aim of the front, advanced and tucked three wide through the turn vying for command and coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide into upper stretch, took over command three-sixteenths from home, edged clear to inside the eighth pole and then had some of that margin cut into late with the outcome in no doubt. SHERBINI two to three wide in pursuit from near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the three-eighths and advanced through the latter portion of the turn, angled five wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to secure the place honors. LONGNECK PAULA chased six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then four wide through the turn, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch and improved position to secure the show honors. CARMEN'S CANDY JAR chased four paths off the inside down the backstretch and then just off the inside through the turn coaxed along from three furlongs out, spun three wide into upper stretch, passed tired rivals. AORAKI established the front shortly after the start and showed the way in hand along the inside under pressure from a pair, had that pressure intensify through the turn and vied inside a pair of rivals coming under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, took the inside route into upper stretch clinging to command, yielded with three-sixteenths to go and weakened to the finish. VIGGIEDAL fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke on top and then prompted the pace three then two wide before vying through the turn under coaxing from the five-sixteenths, spun three then two wide into upper stretch, weakened in the drive. COMPLEXION grew fractious in the gate in four separate incidents leaping up each time and forcing the rider off twice, got backed out and examined and reloaded in the gate, chased just off the inside coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, continued just off the inside into upper stretch and tired. DREAMGIRL chased four then three wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung four wide into upper stretch, tired. WEST MEMORIAL chased along the inside and then just off the inside before heading back to the rail through the turn, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, took the inside route into upper stretch and tired. SLANG chased along the inside, grew choppy gaited down along the rail appearing to balk at first but then got placed to a protective hold by the rider near the half mile pole and was steadily eased up before being pulled up near the midway point on the turn, got loose and ran off sans rider and was apprehended near the seven furlong chute entrance and subsequently transported off the track by equine ambulance. WHATINHELITERAL grew fractious in the gate prior to the start, stumbled badly falling to her face at the start and lost the rider as a result, then got apprehended by outrider and was walked off under her own power.
