TOW NER TOO raced in the middle of the pack through the opening stages, navigated the bend from the four path and finished evenly. BEGGIN FOR TROUBLE was squeezed back at the start, recovered to stalk the leaders on the outside up the backstretch, came around the turn in the two path and weakened in the stretch. CHIPOTLE veered in and bumped with the horse to his inside at the break, recovered to chase the frontrunners between horses through the early going, continued around the bend in the three path and faded in the lane. PIERRE NOEL tracked the leader on the inside up the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and tired in the lane.
