ISCREAMUSCREAM vied for the lead inside rivals leaving the chute, inched ahead to take control first time through the stretch, cleared around the clubhouse turn then took hold leaving the bend, ceded command to WHISKEY DECISION at the fiveeighths pole, stalked that rival up the backstretch, challenged from outside at the five-sixteenths pole, disposed of inner rival entering the lane and stayed clear under urging through the final furlong. MEDORO stalked between runners then started to pull around the first turn, continued in the two path between foes into the far turn, roused at the top of the stretch and steered out to take aim at the winner entering the final furlong but could not summon the needed late kick in deep stretch. ZONA VERDE (IRE) stalked the pace from the rail position, got put in tight briefly past the three-eighths pole, drew closer around the far turn, lacked room in upper stretch, could not rally once gaining a clear path but kept on to hold third. BUCHU settled outside a rival at the back then moved inside when trailing first time through the stretch, went outside a rival on the backstretch and ran up on heels at the seven-sixteenths pole, tipped three wide around the far turn and offered a mild response to earn minor award. SAKURABLOSSOM steered to the two path racing near the back early, moved inside on the farturn then came two wide into the drive and lacked fur ther response. WHISKEY DECISION vied between leaving the chute then took a stalking position in the two path, pulled forward and cleared at the five-eighths pole, showed the way into the far turn, challenged by the winner at the five-sixteenths pole, lost command a quarter mile out and weakened down the lane. CIRCLE OF TRUST unhurried in the beginning along the inside, trailed past the five-sixteenths pole, had one rival beat into the stretch and failed to menace. SEA DANCER showed speed three deep early then took a stalking position outside a pair of rivals, dropped back on the far turn, trailed two wide into the lane and had little left for the drive.
