ROSE MADDOX tucked inside racing towards the rear, crept closer around the far turn still racing along the fence, steered out in upper stretch, rallied and edged COURT SNORT for second. COURT SNORT traveled in the two path near the back, moved inside on the backstretch, hugged the rail to the stretch, moved out a bit in the final furlong, closed determinedly and missed second. CORNELIA FORT tracked in the two path early then between rivals, coaxed along into the far turn, tipped three wide at the quarter pole, showed late effort but got outkicked for the place and show. STAY AND SCAM raced in range from the two path around the first turn then chased from off the pace, drew closer two then three wide on the far turn, bid three deep in upper stretch, lost touch with the winner with a sixteenth remaining and flattened late.
