RAGING TORRENT away quickly to take control, set the pace under pressure up the backstretch, headed by THE CHOSEN VRON at the five-sixteenths pole, dueled inside that rival while in the three path leaving the turn, lost command into the stretch, fought back from inside under strong urging, regained the advantage with a sixteenth remaining and held gamely under flagging from a right handed crop. THE CHOSEN VRON stalked from outside then moved up to apply pressure to RAGING TORRENT, raced on even terms at past the five-sixteenths pole, took over in the four path entering the lane, held a narrow lead over to midstretch, overtaken by RAGING TORRENT at the sixteenth pole and stayed on gamely to the wire. BIG CITY LIGHTS raced in range four deep in the early going, moved into the three path around the bend, then chased four wide turning for home, could not make any headway on the top pair late but finished a clear third. SENOR BUSCADOR lagged behind the field up the backstretch, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, angled from the three path to the five path around the bend and had one rival beat entering the stretch, kept on through the lane and earned a minor award. HAPPY JACK tracked between rivals then altered in a pproaching the half-mile pole, lost ground while staying on the fence through the bend and could not rally. SEE THROUGH IT forwardly placed three deep then steadied behind RAGING TORRENT at the nine-sixteenths pole, chased three then two wide around the bend and faded down the lane. MOOSE MITCHELL fractious in the gate, broke a step slow, raced up close in the early going, ridden along two then three wide on the turn and tire d in the stretch. ARROWT HE GREAT chased wideset up the backstretch, went five deep into the turn, dropped back around the bend, eased in the lane and walked off.
