6½ FURLONGS. (1.15) BC CUP DEBUTANTE S. Purse \$50,000 FOR TWO YEAR OLD FILLIES. The nomination payment of \$100 by midnight Saturday July 27, 2024 with \$750 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$2,500 will be accepted at the time of entry in addition to the races nomination, entry and start fees. 100% of all supplemental monies will be included in the \$50,000 guaranteed purse. \$50,000 guaranteed of which 55% goes to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 4% to fifth, and 2% to sixth through eighth. Preference will be based upon the rules outlined in the Hastings condition book at the time of entry. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$27,500 once allowed 3 lbs. Non-winners of \$12,000 once allowed 5 lbs. Non-winners of \$8,000 once allowed 7 lbs. Field limited to 11 starters. (Clear. 85.)

BREEZIN BRIANNE away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of SOMEDAY LADY, continued to force the issue from the outside of that rival in the run down the backstretch, took control approaching the final turn, and drew clear over the final furlong under confident handling. WHY NOTS A WYNNER away well and stalked the dueling leaders into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, advanced three wide midway down the backside to loom a danger, rallied three wide through the turn, and closed willingly three wide in the drive to prove clearly second best. SOMEDAY LADY was off a step slow, and angled in to vie for the early lead from the inside of BREEZIN BRIANNE entering the first turn, battled from the inside of that rival in the run down the backstretch, was unable to match strides with her pace rival entering the final turn, and weakened over the final furlong. MISS LARUE broke sharply, but was devoid of early speed while trailing the field into the backstretch, was always well back and failed to make an impact.
