BREEZIN BRIANNE away alertly and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the backstretch, dictated the pace in the run down the backside, repelled a challenge by SOMEDAY LADY entering the final turn, and drew clear late to prove best under confident handling. SOMEDAY LADY away well and tracked the leader into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, loomed a threat while commencing her bid two wide entering the final turn, was no match for the pacesetter late, while finishing willingly two wide in the drive to prove easily second best. WHY NOTS A WYNNER stalked the leaders into the backstretch while under snug restraint, launched her bid from along the inside entering the final turn, and finished two wide in the drive to hold on for a share. ZENARI unhurried early while dropping well behind the field entering the backstretch, commenced her bid from along the rail entering the rail entering the final turn, and found her best stride late while closing at the rail in the drive. ANSTRUTHER broke sharply and tracked the leader into the backstretch while racing two out from the rail, struggled to keep pace with the top pair entering the final turn, and faded over the final furlong.
