**7 FURLONGS. ( 1.20<sup>2</sup> ) H. ALLEN JERKENS MEMORIAL S. Grade I. Purse \$500,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Lasix not allowed within 48 hours of post time pursuant to HISA Rule 4212. By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,500 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided accordingly, \$275,000 to the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth, \$20,000 to fifth and \$15,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade One in 2024 or two Grade Two Sweepstakes in 2024 allowed 2 lbs.; of a Grade One or Grade Two Sweepstake allowed 4 lbs.; of a Graded Sweepstake allowed 6 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 10, 2024 with 20 Nominations.**

DOMESTIC PRODUCT settled well off the pace, moved closer while between horses late on the backstretch, was roused in the two then three path on the turn, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed well to make a bid outside the furlong marker, gained a short lead near the sixteenth-pole, fought with the runner-up to the finish and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. PRINCE OF MONACO bumped with a rival at the start, settled nicely off the pace, was roused three then four wide on the turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch, led under a drive until just before the sixteenth-pole then was headed by the winner, battled with that rival to the finish and just missed but earned the place. BOOK'EM DANNO was ridden along well back in the field, went around the turn in the three then two path, gained in the four path into the stretch, moved in behind the leaders nearing the furlong marker, pursued the top two to the finish and willingly earned the show. TIMBERLAKE bumped with rivals on both sides while bobbling at the start, was urged along off the pace, went three wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch, drifted in inside the furlong marker and weakened. REYNOLDS CHANNEL was urged along towards the rear, went around the turn in the two then three path, moved out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. WORLD RECORD was sent hard to the front then set the pace through fast fractions, vied in the two path on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. JEFFERSON STREET was urged along at the rear on the outside, rounded the turn in the three then four path, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. VETTRIANO chased the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn and capitulated. SPEAK EASY was coaxed along off the pace, saved ground on the turn and had nothing left. OTTO THE CONQUEROR bumped with a rival at the start, moved in while coaxed along towards the front, chased inside on the turn and also tired. LITTLE NI was urged along on the outside, traveled around the turn in the five path, turned into the stretch in the six path and also failed to respond.
