THORPEDO ANNA brushed the near side stall at the start, tracked the pace along the inside in close range past the stands and through the first turn, remained inside until tipped out to the two path with six furlongs to run taking up some cover behind the leader, remained on hold just off the rail into the far turn, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths angling three wide at that station to take direct aim on the front, swungfour wide into upper stretch, dugin under a drive rallying to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and got herded out a path late and just missed on the wire.
