STAGE NAME tracked the leaders from five wide down the backstretch, rallied on the turn under a drive, swept up circling the leaders in upper stretch and closed best of all to prevail in the final strides. ALWAYSINTOMISCHIEF broke through the gate pre-race, hustled up the fence to the lead after the first eighth, set the pace under constant pressure from the rail, dug-in gamely through the lane and was bested in the late going. DIAMOND DUST broke alertly to take the early lead, settled in hand to press from three wide through the turn, battled willingly in the stretch drive and was narrowly defeated in a good effort. EMPIRE'S FIRE dueled from between horses down the backside while wellheld, rallied to take a short lead turning for home, pressed on in the drive in a four way match through the stretch and was out-finished in a good try. EXCITEMENT fractious in the gate pre-race, reserved off the pace to midway on the turn and rallied to be prominent in mid-stretch and failed to close ground late. MR LOOOCH reserved off the pace while saving ground through the turn, tipped out two wide to rally rurning for home, was hesitant to split horses in the lane and offered no late kick. HIP HIP HOORAY chased the leaders from five wide through the turn and failed to mount a closing bid. SPECIALIZED broke a step slow, rallied to be in contention turning for home and failed to sustain the bid. CHIEF RANDEL stalked the pace to midway on the turn and steadily faded to the back.
