GENERAL MATHIS well placed just off the pace along the rail to the far turn, was set to a drive midway on the bend, failed to gain on the winner but finished willingly to be clearly second best. I WANNA WIN prompted the pace for a mile, was no match for ht winner and finished evenly through the lane to hold the show. COUNTRY CLUB BOBBY stalked the pacefrom five wide down the backside, failed to mount a closing rally when called upon on the far turn and kept-on in the lane. TANTRUM slow early to be near the rear of the field, commenced a steady gain leaving the half mile pole and made a belated gain in the stretch. SILENCE reserved to track the leaders from five wide down the backside and lacked a response when called upon in the final bend. MISTER MOBIL unhurried in the early going to race near the rear of the field and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. RAVEN MOON pulled early from between rivals down the backstretch to be in contention and went evely never posing a threat. HENRY MAC tracked the leaders to the far turn and came up empty. TEMPERED DREAM was outrun, eased to the wire and walked off.
