LIVE LUCKY pulled the rider to the lead with five furlongs to go, comfortably dictated the pace, moving well up top around the turn and when finally asked in mid-stretch drew away with authority for the victory. SUMMER COMMANDER took control at the start, was shuffled back some positions while on the fence through the turn, shifted out from behind the winner in the two path with a quarter to run and chased in vain to the wire still holding on to best the rest in the end. JO DADDY stalked near the rear on the rail in the early going, kept pace when the field was bunching up midway through the turn, was in range of the winner in the three path at the quarter pole and finished up willingly to be a clear third when crossing the finish line. READY TO COLLECT tracked outside down the backstretch, moved in closer to chase the frontrunner around the bend, was in the thick of things three wide turning for home, could not find another gear and stalled at the furlong marker. JUNIOR HOT SHOT was three wide outside foes in mid-pack down the backstide, was coaxed for more with five sixteenths from home, angled to the five path, having a chance for ashare of the prize in upper stretch but was one paced to the wire. CRIMINAL INTENT settled in mid-division between runners in the early stages, shifted out to be five wide for the drive to the wire but just could not get involved running down the lane to the finish line. ZIPPY GIZ MO trailed the field along the backside, began to pick up horses three wide outside rivals with three eighths to go, angled out widest in the six path when the field fanned out straightening for the drive but lacked a rally through the stretch.
