ORI was hustled from the gate, moved in while going to the front, showed the way in the two path, was asked under threatat the five-sixteenths pole, lost the advantage at the guarter-pole, fought on gamely in the stretch, regained the advantage coming to the sixteenth-pole but was denied by the winner while just able to get the place. DYNAMIC PRICING (IRE) raced in the three path on the first turn, settled on the outside but with the benefit of cover, was roused while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, pursued the leaders while outside in the drive, swapped back to her inside lead near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly to just miss the place while up for the show. POOLSIDE WITH SLIM (IRE) broke in while away awkwardly then bumped with a foe, rounded the first turn in the three path, settled towards the front on the outside, went around the far turn in the three path, was asked late on that bend, turned into the stretch in the fourpath, made a bid near the furlong marker but was outfinished. PROCTOR STREET stalked the pace on the outside in the three path, engaged the leader on the far turn, took a short advantage at the quarter-pole, led under a drive into the final fur long, was headed outside the six teenthpole and out-kicked.
