By subscription of \$50 for each mare –in–foal or foal on ground nominated on or before April 1, 2022. To remain eligible a further subscription of \$100 is due by Satur day April 1,2024 (Two–Year–Old). Final payment of \$200 to accompany the nomination by Midnight Satur day September 7, 2024 with \$1500 to enter and an additional \$2,000 to start. \$100,000 guaranteed of which 55% goes to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 4% to fifth, and 2% to sixth through eighth. MOUNT DOOM broke sharply and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the first turn, set a pressured pace from the inside of RONDELITO in the run down the backside, maintained his advantage into the final turn, and inched clear late while being kept to task. PUTTINGONTHEFOIL away alertly and stalked the early pace while racing two out from the rail, commenced his bid three wide entering the final turn, and closed willingly from along the rail in the drive to get up for the place in the final strides. KRIS'S GOLD stalked the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the backstretch, launched his bid from along the rail entering the final turn, shifted two wide for the drive and closed determinedly and just failed to hold the place. COUNTER CAT settled off the early pace while saving ground along the inside entering the backstretch, rallied from along the rail entering the final turn, and finished evenly late three out from the rail in the drive. WHO IS stalked the early pace while racing four wide into the backstretch, rallied three out from the rail entering the final turn, and finished evenly four wide in the drive. CHICK COMMAND away well and was taken in hand and allowed to settle off the early pace, rallied three wide entering the final turn, but failed to make a late impact when called upon. RON DELITO tracked the pacesetter into the backstretch while racing one out from the rail, forced the issue in the run to the final turn, before weakening over the final furlong.
