MONEYSHOT unhurried early while trailing the field into the stretch the first time, continued to bide his time at the back of the pack in the run down the backstretch, rallied smartly two wide entering the final turn, shifted five wide midway through the turn for clear sailing, and finished strongly five wide in the drive to prove clearly second best. J DUTTON away well and tracked the leaders while racing three out from the rail entering the stretch the first time, advanced smartly three wide midway down the backstretch and collared the leaders entering the final turn, held the narrowest of leads leaving the turn, was quickly overhauled entering the lane, but finished willingly two wide in the drive to hole on for a share. CLASSY CITY tracked the dueling leaders through the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail. maintained his tracking trip in the run down the backside, rallied along the inside entering the final turn, shifted off the rail leaving the turn and finished two out from the rail in the drive to just miss the show position. TOUGHERTHANTHEREST away alertly and dueled for the lead from the outside of SHOCK THE HOUSE entering the stretch the first time, continued to force the issue two wide into the backstretch, battled for the lead from along the inside through the final turn, was overtaken leaving the turn, and finished determinedly two wide in the drive. WESTMINSTER stalked the early pace while racing one out from the rail through the stretch the first time, advanced smartly four wide midway down the backside and engaged the leaders three out from the rail entering the final turn, was bumped turning for home, and finished three wide in the drive. DIOCLEs settled off the early pace while saving ground at the rail through the stretch the first time, continued to save ground under snug restraint in the run down the backstretch, rallied smartly two wide through the final turn, took up sharply when pinched between rivals leaving the turn, and lost all momentum, and finished four wide in the drive. WHAT'S SHAKIN settled off the early pace while racing two wide through the stretch the first time, continued to bide his time well off the contested early pace in the run down the backstretch, saved ground into the final turn, and finished three wide in the drive. SKIPPER'S PRIDE settled off the early pace while racing four wide through the stretch the first time, continued with a wide trip in the run down the backside, rallied three wide entering the final turn, and finished five wide in the drive while unable to mount a serious late bid. HORATIO broke sharply and tracked the leaders through the stretch the first time while racing two out from the rail, pushed his way out four wide entering the backstretch, held a striking position in the run to the final turn, but was outfinished in the late stages. LORD OF BATTLE settled off the early pace while racing three wide through the lane the first time, remained well back in the run down the backstretch, raced four wide into the final turn, but failed to make an impact. SHOCK THE HOUSE rushed up from along the rail to vie for the early lead from along the rail entering the first turn, continued to set a pressured pace through the second turn and in the run down the backside, dropped back sharply approaching the final turn, and was eased over the final furlong.
