With \$20,000—added of which 60% of the total monies to the owner of the winner; 20% to second; 12% to third; 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. **Weights:** 3-year-olds 122 lbs. **Non-winners of \$9,000 in 2023–24 allowed 3 lbs.** Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in allowances. **High Weights Preferred, on the scale.** Total earnings in 2023–24 will be used in determining the preference of horses assigned equal weights. Preference to Horses that have started a race in the State of Nebraska in 2024. Closed Friday, Sept. 13 with ten nominations. (Clear. 80.)

DIAMONDSFORAYBRIE stalked the pace, raced four to five wide into the upper stretch and was even with no closing run on the top pair. CHANT NATION was allowed to settle early and failed to respond. THATTA PEPPA sent along, was done early, was eased and walked off the track under her own power.
