6 FURLONGS. (1071) IOWA CRADLE S. Purse \$110,000 (includes \$60,000 IBF – Iowa Bred Fund) FOR COLTS AND GELDINGS, TWO-YEAR-OLDS WHICH WERE NOMINATED AND REMAIN ELIGIBLE FOR THE IOWA CRADLE. (Iowa Registered and Foaled). Weight: 122 lbs.; Non-winners of \$60,000 once or \$45,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$45,000 allowed 4 lbs.; maidens allowed 6 lbs. *Late nomination fee of \$15,000 will be accepted at time of entry with \$7,500 allocated towards guaranteed purse monies and \$7,500 to I.T.B.O.A. \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$700 to start. \$110,000 guaranteed which will first be reduced so as to allow \$500 to be paid to each of the seventh through last place finishers with the remaining purse paid out as follows: 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth, 2% to sixth. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to start will be given to those horses having accumulated the highest earnings at the closing time of entries. This preference will be utilized regardless of the ownership of the horses involved. This race will not be divided and will have a maximum number of twelve (12) starters. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

AMOROSA raced two wide between rivals in a compact flight in the opening quarter, angled to the inside mid-way around the turn, given cue turning for home, quickly grabbed the lead, repelled bid from CAN DO ANDREW near the furlong marker and finished going away. CAN DO ANDREW raced up close in early stages, vied for the lead at the quarter pole, edged closer on AMOROSA near the furlong marker, could not reach eventual winner but ran on and held place. FIVE CHARLIE raced in range along the outside, swung five paths wide into upper stretch, stayed on with response and secured a share. ON A HUNCH was ridden along the inside just off the compact top flight, urged two wide around the turn, angled to the inside, moved up closer a furlong out then flattened. MO LUTE was forwardly placed in the opening quarter, chased two to three wide around the turn, kept on two wide past the furlong marker and lacked a late needed kick for impact. BAND'S FREE SPIRIT raced off the early pace, saved ground then hustled along three wide into upper stretch and lacked a needed rally. BIG MAN STAN raced off the early pace, came four wide into upper stretch and failed to move on. VIRTUE'S REWARD raced up close in opening quarter along the inside then gave way mid-way around the turn. RUN FOR GOLD set a pressured pace, vied at the quarter pole then tired in the drive. BETTER THAN GOOD raced in the back, steadily retreated and jogged in.
