1 1/8 MILES. (Inner Turf) (1.39) BERNARD BARUCH S. Purse \$150,000 INNER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Lasix not allowed within 48 hours of post time pursuant to HISA Rule 42.12. By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$750 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded sweepstakes in 2024 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes other than State-bred in 2024 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-bred allowance in 2024 allowed 6 lbs. Preference to start will be determined by Graded Stake winners, Graded Stake placed runners, non-restricted stake winners, condition eligibility. Any ties in respective conditions will be broken by total earnings. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. Closed Saturday, August 17, 2024 with 19 Original Nominations and 1 Supplement (Rail at 18 feet).

RUNNING BEE settled tracking the pace along the inside patiently handled until placed to coaxing nearing the quarter pole, angled four wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge inside the final furlong and seized command asixteenth from home, then edged away to the finish to prevail. TAKING CANDY got away to an awkward beginning, tracked just off the inside from just off the pace patiently handled until set down spinning three wide into upper stretch, rallied to take narrow command a furlong out, dug in under threat and was collared asixteenth from home, ran on safe for the place honors. FORT WASHINGTON saved ground at the tail of the field, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun just off the inside at the quarter pole before taking to the inside straightened away, tipped out a furlong out to the four path inside that station and kicked on belatedly to garner the show honors. BEUYS (IRE) got bumped at the start by REBEL RED, who broke inwards, saved ground in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled out six wide into upper stretch and stayed on one pace d through to the finish. PIONEERING SPIRIT settled just off the inside near the rear of the field, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled out seven to eight wide into upper stretch, offered up a bid but was outkicked. STEADY ON bobbed at the break, recovered to advance and establish the front shortly after settling in hand along the inside through the first turn, briefly tipped to the two path into the backstretch before taking back residence along the hedge, had TAKING CANDY advance outside to apply pressure into the far turn and patiently got waited with until placed to coaxing just outside the quarter pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, dug in under threat and was collared a furlong from home and weakened in the late stages. REBEL RED (GB) broke in a step at the start bumping BEUYS, raced just off the inside through the first turn before tracking the front three then two wide, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, angled four to five wide into upper stretch and weakened to the finish.
