By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$750 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% tofourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded sweepstake in 2024 allowed 2 lbs; of a sweepstake other than State-bred in 2024 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-bred allowance in 2024 allowed 6 lbs. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, August 17, 2024 with 18 Original Nominations and 2 Supplements. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the Main Track). (Rail at 12 feet).

BIG INVASION bumped with a rival at the start then dropped back, moved in whilesettling off the pace, went around most of the turn in the two path, shifted to the three then four path late on that bend, came five wide into the stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. OUR SHOT was urged along on the outside, brushed with an opponent leaving the backstretch, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong then swapped back to his inside lead, closed well to make a bid inside of the winner late but just missed while able to get the place. SOUPER QUEST broke out and bumped with a foe, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, took a short lead coming to the furlong marker, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the show. ARZAK was coaxed along off the pace, brushed with a rival leaving the backstretch, traveled around the turn in the two path, moved out some under a drive in upper stretch, chased in the final furlong and lacked the needed kick. HIGH FRONT brushed with a foe at the start then went to the front, vied in the two path on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, lost the advantage near the furlong marker and was outfinished. SMITHWICK'S SPICE was hustled from the gate then chased the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, pursued the leader while behind that foe in upperstretch, had room into the final furlong, continued in pursuit as the hole tightened into the final sixteenth, was crowded along the rail late and also out-kicked. SURVEILLANCE brushed with a foe at the start, was urged along off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, moved out outside the furlong marker and failed to rally. MISTER MMMMM was bumped on both sides at the start then squeezed back, angled in at the rear, moved out leaving the backstretch, went around the turn in the three then four path. came six wide into the stretch, moved out while still on his inside lead near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. CHARGING was hustled from the gate then chased the pace, went around the turn in the two path and came up empty.
