7 FURLONGS. (1.20²) HOPEFUL S. Grade I. Purse \$300,000 FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. Lasix not allowed within 48 hours of post time pursuant to HISA Rule 4212. By subscription of \$300 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 in addition to the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden allowed 2 lbs; maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, August 17, 2024 with 24 Nominations.

CHANCER MCPATRICK broke in and hit the gate soundly then bumped hard with a foe, had the rider lose his left iron then reached down to regain footing before going a sixteenth of a mile, settled unhurried while well off the pace, picked up stride in the three then four path on the turn, rallied seven wide into upper stretch, closed well on the outside of the runner-up into the final furlong, gained into the final sixteenth and got up to prevail. FEROCIOUS broke out and bumped hard with a foe, established a forward position while climbing a bit into the kickback, moved out outside the five-eighths pole then chased the pace, pursued the leader in the three then four path on the turn, was driven into the stretch in the five path under the crop, chased the leader while joined on the outside by the winner inside the three-sixteenths pole, gained alongside that foe under a long drive to make a bid near the sixteenth-pole, fought to the finish and missed while clear for the place. INCENTIVE PAY hit the inside of the gate, moved in while settling off the pace, was roused in the two then three path on the turn, dropped back to the two path into the stretch, gained under a drive to make a bid inside the leader into the final furlong, battled into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the show. SMOKEN WICKED went to the front, showed the way under pressure to his outside, vied along the rail on the turn, spun into the two path entering the stretch then drifted out under a left-handed crop while inching clear, led past sixteenth-pole then was overtaken while well clear for fourth position. INNOVATOR was bumped hard at the start then forced into another rival, settled off the pace then moved into a good position, was asked while inside to the two path on the turn, chased into upper stretch and came up empty. MENTEE bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, turned into the stretch in the three path and tired. STUPLYDORIGHT broke out and hit the gate then bumped with a rival, was ridden along off the pace, saved ground on the turn, turned into the stretch in the three path, steadied behind horses near the furlong marker and failed to threaten. TOUGH CATCH bumped with a rival at the start, moved out while urged along off the pace, chased in the four then five path on the turn, was driven into the six path at the quarter-pole, dropped back while remaining on his inside lead in upper stretch and came up empty. MR. MENDELSLEW was slow into stride, settled at the rear then dropped well behind, saved ground on the turn and trailed.
