VIXEN prompted the pace three deep along the backstretch, was reined back a touch to track the top two rivals three wide around the bend, angled out six wide having clear run turning for home, moved in to duel up front outside at the furlong pole, dug in tenaciously late but was just outkicked in the final few strides before the finish line. NITROGEN assumed the lead inside down the backside, continued to dictate terms up front while shadowed on the outside by the winner throughout the turn, fought on courageously clinging onto the lead in the stretch with rivals closing in and just gave way grudgingly to the stablemates late to settle for a clear third. ITALIAN SOIREE tracked the lead three some while outside a rival down the back straight, kept pace with the front three runners between horses in the turn, angled four wide just behind the embattled trio straightening out for the drive, shifted out further in the six path with an eighth to go and won the minor battle to settle on the fringes at the wire. READY TO BATTLE was brushed outside to be near the back of the field in the beginning, took closer order smartly on the fence by the half, shifted out five wide at the top of the lane, drifted in under right-handed encouragement at the furlong marker and just missed for a small piece of the prize. ANNASCAUL had a good position on the rail tracking the top three in the early going, sat patiently behind the frontrunner on the fence throughout the turn waiting for the cue, skimmed the fence turning for home in range of the contesting leaders and was willingly in the lane but lost the duel for a minor role in the end. READY FOR CANDY was ahead of one runner down the backside, made little advance three wide with rivals on both sides around the turn, shifted out eight wide straightening for the wire and passed some tired horses in the stretch.
