SACROSANCT coaxed from the gate, prompted the leader from the outsidesixthen five paths off therail down the backstretch, tucked to the three path into the turn and advanced to duel with that rival from the three-eighths, swung three then two wide into upper stretch let out for the drive and seized command straightened away, then edged away to the finish to prevail. MO PLEX coaxed from the start, cut the pace five then four wide down the backstretch under some pressure from SACROSANCT to the outside, tucked to the two path into the turn and came under increasing pressure dueling from the three-eighths with his main rival, took the inside route into upper stretch and was headed straightened away, dug in along the inside through to the finish but was shaken off by the top one while clear of the rest and along second best. SOONTOBEKING chased three then two wide coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung three wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick and just bested a rival on the wire for the show honors. SMILENSAYCHEESE broke out at the start, raced seven paths off the inside down the backstretch until tucked to the three path with nine-sixteenths to go, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, swung five then four wide for home and offered up a mild bid. PAY THE JUICE chased just off the inside and then along the inside coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and then three wide through the turn under encouragement from the three-eighths marker, went four wide into upper stretch in retreat and was eased home through to the finish.
