CHANGE THE WORLD settled outside on the opening turn then saved ground into the second turn, eased out into the backstretch and started her bid at the seven sixteenths pole, closed five wide through the far turn, dug in for the lead late yards and was drawing away nearing the wire. JUBA'S PARADE stalked off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole and took the lead nearing the five sixteenths, raced clear at the rail on the far turn and dug in from the head of the lane, but was met while flattening stride late yards. FOXY SISTA was pinched back and bumped leaving the gate then saved ground, bid nearing the three eighths pole, raced close in the three path on the far turn then flattened stride. SOMEDAY IS TODAY settled off the rail early, eased out into the backstretch and gave chase from the three eighths pole, raced close off the rail on the far turn but flattened toward mid-stretch. THE SKY IS FALLING raced wellback in the three and four paths, picked up the chase from the nine sixteenths pole, rounded the far turn about the four path and flattened in the lane. SENECAROCK S veered in leaving the gate then stalked off the rail, took the lead at the nine sixteenths pole and came under pressure nearing the three eighths, gave up the lead at the five sixteenths and weakened near the rail on the far turn. NO DENYING DENIS was not a factor while mostly saving ground BONNIE BLUETOOTH settled in the three and four paths, gave chase nearing the three eighths polebut weakened into the far turn. JUMPIN JACK BRASS was pinched back and bumped at the break and never factored. CRUZ IN THE CASTLE veered out at the break then rated the pace inside, was caught at the nine sixteenths pole, faded through the backstretch and was eased the final quarter mile.
