COALINGA ROAD broke in and crowded a neighboring rival at the start, was a step slow to begin but recovered and settled in the second flight heading to the first turn, tracked the moderate pace while inside of rivals into the backstretch, well placed at the half-mile pole, gained ground and loomed from the inside nearing the quarter pole, vied for the lead into upper stretch, took a narrow advantage at the furlong marker and led past mid-stretch, was overtaken by LAMMAS into the final sixteenth, fought gamely into deep stretch but was outfinished late and was a clear second. NO SECRET broke alertly, assumed early command and cleared the field passing the wire for the first time, set a prompted pace into the first turn, carved out moderate fractions while prompted through the backstretch run, was pressured into the far turn and led to the quarter pole, battled into upper stretch and lost the lead nearing the furlong grounds, stayed on stubbornly into the final sixteenth, could not match strides with the leading pair into deep stretch and held safely late for third.
