CARL SPACKLER (IRE) set the pace along the inside as an outer rival applied pressure, built a clear margin turning for home, kicked clear entering the lane and held from an on-charging rival late. MORE THAN LOOKS broke a step slow, gotfloated out while trailing into the first turn, rated at the rear in the two path, shifted five wide in midstretch, rallied while a strong kick in the final sixteenth and was gaining on the clear leader late. MOUNTAIN BEAR (IRE) bore out to the four path into the first turn, but was guickly corrected and tucked to the inside to rate off of the pace around that bend, pursued from the two path around the far turn, shifted four wide into the lane, delayed changing leads until midstretch, rallied in the final furlong to bid for place along with an outer rival, but got outkicked. RUNNING BEE steadied approaching the first turn, tracked along the inside, chased the clearing leader into the lane and kept on evenly. SPIRIT OF ST LOUIS took light contact from an inner rival passing the seven furlong pole, stalked tucking from the five path to the three path around the first turn, chased the clearing leader while vying for place into the lane, battled for that position while hanging on his left lead into the final furlong, but had a hind heel clipped by a rival at the sixteenth pole, got outkicked by an outer pair and yielded late. KIKKULI (GB) bobbled subtly leaving the gate, laid off of the pace two wide under restraint around the first turn, attempted to shift out but was kept hemmed in behind foes by an outer rival entering the final furlong, ran up behind traffic shortly after, clipped a rival's heels and bobbled at the sixteenth pole and failed to recover. CASH EQUITY (FR) laid off of the pace keen three wide, shifted out to the six to seven path in upper stretch and lacked a rally. TALK OF THE NATION prompted outside of the eventual winner, but failed to sustain pressure turning for home, yielded between horses entering the lane and gave way. NOISES OFF checked between horses nearing the first turn, tracked two wide and among rivals, chased in the three path around the far turn and tired.
