MI BAGO tracked the leaders while having rivals on either side down the backstretch, was nudged for more edging closer at the guarter pole and under avigorous ride being urged left handed through the stretch got up in the shadow of the wire for the victory. DARE TO BREEZE prompted the pace three wide on the outside, chased the leader outside throughout the turn, rallied smartly in the lane to poke her head in front with a sixteenth from the wire but just missed holding on for the win in the final few jumps. BULLET had a sluggish beginning to trail at the break, gathered herself in the third flight on the rail stalking down the backstretch, shifted out four wide for the drive to the wire and was gaining strongly in the stretch but could not get there in time. SHAREDASHENANIGANS settled on the fence watching the front two in the early stages, moved closer to be in range in the two path at the three sixteenths pole and kept on stubbornly fighting to the end for a minor placing at the finish. UN BRIDLED WEATHER stalked near the rear in the two path outside, came under a ride losing ground to rivals throughout the turn and while two wide in the stretch drive did manage to show late interest to pass some horses in the stretch. POP ROX trailed the field at the half mile while climbing down the backside, saved ground but was seeing the field around the turn and could not reach contention running down the stretch. MENSA broke out on the break, emerged from the group of five to have a slim lead in the two path at the half setting abrisk early pace, rolled along up front while hounded outside through the turn, was clinging onto the leadinside with a furlong remaining, had little left late and stopped in the last sixteenth of a mile. FRENCH HORN broke out on the start, travelled in the second flight three deep down the back straight, tracked the embattled pair three wide around the turn, angled out five wide for the stretch run but faltered by the furlong pole.
