WINTERBERRY stumbled badly on the break, settled in midfield four deep on the outside in hand at the half, cruised past rivals on the outside with ease three wide at the three-furlong pole, opened up to a commanding lead by upper stretch, began to get leg weary late but did hold on by a quickly diminishing margin at the wire from the oncoming stable mate. CHARL OTTE'S HEART was unhurried loping along at the rear, took closer or der lengthening stride strongly at the three furlong pole, weaved through runners on the turn reaching for more ground passing rivals, loomed the only threat four wide at the top of the lane, finished up with a powerful late rush and made it interesting at the wire but settled for second best on this day. NATA TROUBLE forced the issue on the rail at the start, poked her head in front by the half, was hard ridden with five sixteenths to go losing the lead to the eventual winner through the turn, shifted out three wide straightening out for the drive and stayed on stubbornly to be a distant third in the end. MISS SAUGERTIES broke inwards to begin, was in the mix three wide between foes early on, throttled down at the half to track in midfield, could not quicken with rivals while travelling three wide on the turn, angled out widest in the six path turning for home and finished up one paced to the wire to settle on the fringes. NEENAH was brushed inside at the start, tugged at the rider vying between horses up top in the three path down the backside, continued to duel between foes at the half, could not match strides with the top two rivals by midturn, angled out four wide for the stretch drive but tired drifting inside in the final furlong. SOUPER SUPREME broke out on the start, assumed control four deep outside in the beginning, was relegated to a pressing role three wide giving up the lead at the half, could not keep up with others making a move with three eighths left to run, backed away abruptly around the bend and was not persevered with late while galloping down the stretch crossing the wire.
