GOOD CHEER bumped with an outer rival at the start, settled off of the pace two wide and between horses, shifted out four wide nearing the half mile pole, launched progress into the far turn, bid three deep passing the three furlong pole, sparred with her inner stable mate turning for home, gained an advantage entering the lane, drew clear in upper stretch under moderate hand urging and held sway while ridden out. QUIET SIDE bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, tracked three wide, got outmoved by an outer bidder into the far turn, chased the leaders turning for home, then ran on well to claim place at the furlong grounds and was second best. ECL ATANT stalked outside of the early leader, pressed down the backstretch, vied as her stable mate made an outer bidder at the three furlong pole, led briefly before being headed by that one entering the lane, gave way through the final furlong yet narrowly saved show at the wire. STURGEON MOON bumped an inner rival at the start, laid off of the pacefour wide, was urged along in pursuit in the three path around the far turn, then stayed on but missed reeling in a tiring rival for show. FLASH WEAR bobbled slightly leaving the gate, raced at the rear five wide into the first turn, tucked down to the two path trailing into the backstretch, took the far turn in the three path and made little impact. FIXIN TO BEE tracked along the inside chase daround the far turn, shifted out to the five to six path in upper stretch and gave way. MY LIL PUNK Y set the pace along the inside, vied with an outer presser as a wider bidder joined the fray at the three furlong pole, gave way to them turning for home and weakened.
