CLOVISCONNECTION bobbled slightly at the start, recovered and stalked the solid early pace outside of BOB'S BLUE MOON, pressed the pace three wide into the turn, roused at the quarter pole, vied for the lead into upper stretch, took a narrow lead at the furlong marker, kept to task and dug in into the final sixteenth, held foes at bay into deep stretch and edged away late to prove best. ZEUS' WAR took a couple of awkward strides leaving the start but was away in good order, settled off of the solid early pace while never far back, tracked between runners approaching the turn, gained ground along the bend and went two to three wide nearing the guarter pole, tipped four wide into upper stretch and ran evenly to the furlong marker, rallied while widest into the final sixteenth, could not reel in the winner into deep stretch and got up for second in the final strides. REGAL PATRIOT was forwardly placed away from the start, tracked the solid early pace from the inside, was well placed into the turn and stalked the pace nearing the guarter pole. I opped into upper stretch and vied for the lead at the furlong marker, battled into the final six teenth. was outfinished in deep stretch and just missed for second, while just holding for third. BOB'S BLUE MOON hustled to the early lead, showed good speed and carved out quick fractions heading to the half-mile marker, set the pace off of the rail into the turn, was pressed to the guarter pole by CLOVISCONNECTION, met that rival's bid and battled to the furlong grounds, fought on into the final sixteenth, yielded in deep stretch and was outfinished for the minor awards. LMLOOKNFORMISCHIEF settled off of the solid early pace while never far back, tracked three wide and between runners heading to the half-mile pole, chased three to four wide into the turn and gained ground at the quarter marker, could not keep pace into upper stretch and gave way in the stretch drive. ESTABLISHED tracked the solid early pace from outside of rivals, chased the quick pace four to five wide into the turn, lost position nearing the guarter marker, was outrun into the stretch and tired in the late stages.
