POP IDOL broke sharply taking control from the onset on the rail, opened up comfortably in hand through the turn, ran them off their feet spurting away in upper stretch and was kept to the task late to hold safe for the frontrunning score. NATA TROUBLE was in the mix up top three wide between rivals down the backside, came under a ride three wide on the turn but could not reel in the pacesetter, never wavered down the stretch chasing the winner and actually closed the gap late to be second best on this day. WAR SIGNAL was reluctant to load, veered out on the start, could see the field down the backside, made little impression in the two path around the turn, shifted to the four path at the top of the lane and had a strong finish reaching for ground smartly in deep stretch to get up capturing the third money. PERIWINKLE was squeezed to trail at the start, improved down the backstretch to tuck in on the fence in mid-pack at the half, kept pace but was under a ride in midturn, shifted to the rail with an eighth left to run dueling for the show award but had to settle for a minorshare at the finish line. WINTERBERRY tracked between runners in the beginning, was roused with five sixteenth from home but could not quicken with the winneraround the turn, had little left for the stretch drive and faded in the two path at the fur long marker. MISS PIERRE travelled in midfield four deep outside rivals down the backside, made little headway going three wide around the bend, shifted to the five path outside foes for the stretch run but could not factor in the drive to the wire. DANCET OT HERHYTHM settle don the rail near the rearalong the backside, dropped back to rear on the fence with three eighths remaining, saved ground through the turn but had little to show in the stretch drive.
